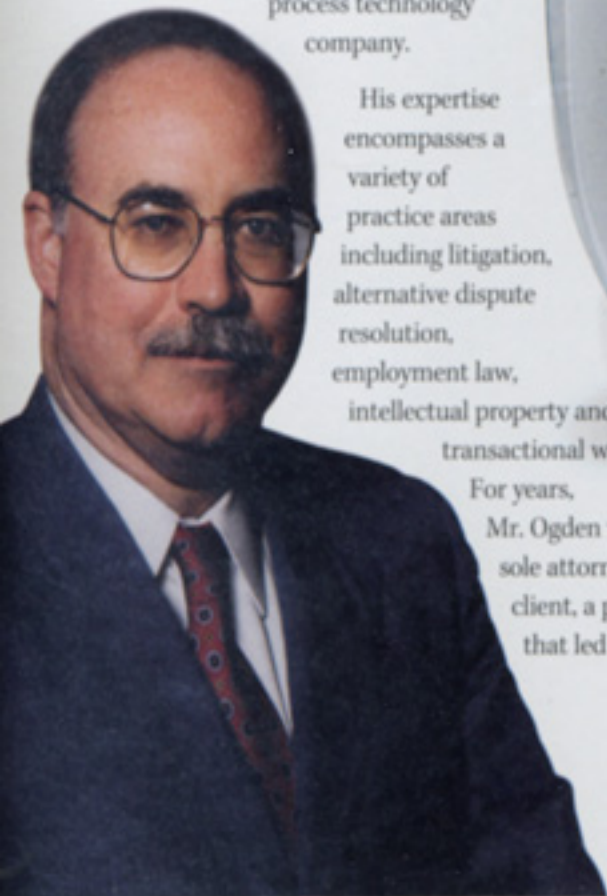
His expertise encompasses a variety of practice areas including litigation, alternative dispute resolution, employment law, intellectual property and transactional work.
