## John Ogden Named To Foundation Board, Wins Commission's Professionalism Award

John H. Ogden has been appointed a trustee of the New Jersey State Bar Foundation, the educational and philanthropic arm of the New Jersey State Bar Association.

General Counsel, Corporate Secretary and Director of Contract Management at Krupp Werner & Pfleiderer Corporation, Mr. Ogden is Past President of the New Jersey Corporate Counsel Association and is a member of the American Corporate Counsel Association Board of Directors. He recently was named Chairman of ACCA's newly created Leadership Development Institute. In addition, he serves as Assistant Secretary of Krupp Werner & Pfleiderer Corporation's parent company, Krupp USA, Inc.

Mr. Ogden also recently was presented the New Jersey Commission on Professionalism in the Law's 1998 Professional Lawyer of the Year Award.

The Professional Lawyer of the Year Awards are given annually to those attorneys who have demonstrated an extraordinary commitment to professionalism throughout their careers in the law. A county or specialty bar association in New Jersey has nominated each attorney receiving the awards.

Nominated by the New Jersey Corporate Counsel Association, Mr. Ogden was presented with the award at the Commission's Symposium on Professionalism held recently at the New Jersey Law Center in New Brunswick.

Mr. Ogden writes on various subjects including corporate counsel's role in performing legal and business functions and litigation by the corporate generalist. He is co-author of the *Small Law Department Practitioner's Desk Manual*.
